Playwrights are invited to join the 2010 winter season of a new writing group based at the Brockley Jack Theatre, which will be led by workshop tutor and playwright David Bottomley, (Writers Group Director of the London Playwrights Collective).

The Brockley Jack Writers Workshop is a new, dynamic hub for emerging contemporary theatre writing in South London. The group will meet at the Brockley Jack Theatre on Monday evenings from January 2010 (7.30-9.30pm).

We are seeking writers with commitment to attend all sessions to support the development of scripts and individual members. Together we shall be expanding skills and understanding of writing within a friendly environment.

The sessions will explore all elements of playwriting using writing exercises, workshopping, collective writing, discussions, group feedback and improvisation.

The season is divided into eight sessions and gives you the opportunity to submit a script for a rehearsed reading at the Brockley Jack Theatre.

Selected scripts will be given a platform performance in Summer 2010.
